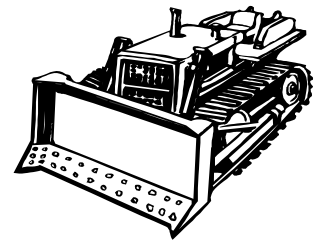

Heavy Equipment Program Details

Heavy Equipment Programs Include:

- Classroom training
- Hands-on equipment training
- Lab/Field work

Program Pre-Requisites:

Applicants Must:

- Be minimum 18 years old
- Provide proof of a minimum of Ontario Grade 10 Education at the time of registration. Copies of School transcripts, OSSD or GED diplomas are required for our records. Education Equivalency Testing is available to be done at our office if you do not meet the education requirements or do not have proof of required level of education. This must be done *prior* to registration.
- Have the following safety equipment at the start of the program. We do not sell these items.
 - Green Triangle Patch Safety Boots Class E Hard Hat Tear Away Safety Vest (velcro at sides)
 - Eye Protection Ear Protection

Note: Insulated clothing or coveralls are recommended for winter season. Safety (orange or green) clothing with reflective tape markings is acceptable as long as it is an outer garment.

Having a driver's licence is NOT a requirement to operate or take a Heavy Equipment Training Program, however, you will be responsible for arranging your own transportation to off-campus training sites (if required). Most companies do require their operators to have a driver's licence, as they may have to drive the equipment on a public road in the course of transporting it to a job site.

Payment of Course: Tuition is due at the time of registration.

Applicants must register at our office *prior* to the course start date. *Acceptable forms of payment are Cash, Visa, MasterCard, American Express, Certified Cheque, Money Order or BankDraft.*

If you are being financed through this course, you must provide written confirmation from your sponsor or a signed MTCU contract at the time of registration.

Certification: Certificates and wallet cards will be issued to applicants upon successful completion

NOTE: If you are combining a Heavy Equipment Course with a Truck Training Course, additional classrooms and in-truck training will be added. There will also be additional pre-requisite costs. Please refer to our truck course information package for more information.

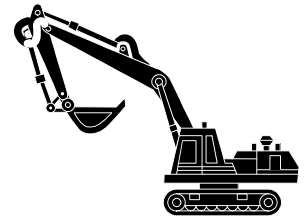

Heavy Equipment Course Outline

<i>Job Communications & Evaluate the Job Site</i>
Communication with others in the work environment. Inspect the work layout area and apply line, grades and off-set.
<i>Perform Pre-start Inspection</i>
Complete walk-around inspection. Perform daily maintenance. Lubricate the machine and top up all fluid levels.
<i>Complete Operational Checks</i>
Start the engine. Monitor engine performance, electrical system, brake system, air cleaner indicator and warning systems. Cycle the machine.
<i>Operational Procedures</i>
Practice safe operating procedures including warm and cold weather starting, stripping, cutting, filling, carrying, lifting and dumping the bucket, loading from a bank or stockpile, peeling and scraping, backfilling, breaking and spreading large piles, and various types of trenching procedures.
<i>Complete Shut-Down and Parking Procedures</i>
Prepare machine for parking and park the machine. Perform shut-down procedures with the engine running and shut off. Place warning signs around parked equipment.
<i>Perform Machine Adjustment and Maintenance</i>
Track adjustment and machine maintenance procedures.
<i>Load, Transport, Unloading Procedures</i>
Prepare the machine for transport. Load machine on float. Secure the machine on float and unload the machine.
<i>Introduction to Survey and Layout</i>
Introduce and familiarize students with equipment used by surveyors and contractors for determining grades, depths and other job site measurements
<i>Surface Miner Common Core Program (classroom theory)</i>
This certification is required for drivers and operators that do extraction work in quarries or sand pits. This program teaches three modules in its Common Core course, which are now mandatory under the Mining Act.
